## West Texas Futurity Health and Safety Protocols

- 1) All horses entering the Amarillo Tri State Fairgrounds must have a current (12 months) Coggins
- 2) Out of state horses must have a health certificate dated within 30 days of entry to facility
- 3) Bring a copy of all required documents that we can keep for our records. It will speed up entry to the facility.
- 4) Representatives of Texas Animal Health will be on site to monitor compliance with animal protocols
- 5) Horses not complying with requirements will not be able to unload
- 6) Participants may not arrive before 1 P.M. on Thursday, August 6<sup>th</sup>
- 7) Everyone over the age of 18 that comes on the grounds must fill out a general liability waiver form. In return persons will be given a wristband that they must have for re-entry onto the grounds. It is recommended by the Amarillo Tri-State Exposition that persons wear their wristband on their wrist instead of keeping in pocket, vehicle, bag, etc.
- 8) All contestants and attendees will be held responsible for providing and utilizing their own personal protective equipment, including but not limited to face protection, gloves, etc. The Amarillo Tri-State Exposition will have hand sanitizer located around the grounds for patron's usage.
- 9) All contestants and attendees will be required to wear face mask/protection in common area, including but not limited to the stands, show office, stall office, vendor booths, and bathrooms. Face protection astride and at halter will be considered optional. The Amarillo Tri-State Exposition will have face masks available for purchase.
- 10) Gate 3 will be the only entrance and exit to the facility
- 11) Practice social distancing
- 12) Wash your hands, often
- 13) Use hand sanitizer
- 14) No more than 40 horses will be allowed in the Amarillo National Center at one time
